<b>Level</b>	TOPIK 1 to 6, Organize class after placement test Organize level 1 class if the applicants do not have knowledge of Korean		
<b>Criteria of Completion</b>	Above 70% for academic grade, above 80% for attendance; if criteria are not satisfied, the student will be suspended (maximum 2 year period for completion)		
<b>Other</b>	Cultural experiences, student counselling, athletic events, etc.

- International students who plan to graduate from high school and who enter a bachelor's program within 1 year after completion of Korean language course.

## ■ Evaluation for Korean language course

- Documentation review 50% + Interview 50% (Interview will be done online)
- Standard for students with tied scores: All students with tied scores will be selected

## ■ Admission procedures for Korean language course

- Submit application form to International Affairs Team → Screening process → Successful applicants receive confirmation → Successful applicants remit to designated account → Issue confirmation of admission letter → Apply for Korean visa at Korean embassy(consulate) in their home country.

Financial Background	[5-1] <b>Certificate of Bank balance</b> copy (notarized in English if it is not in English) of applicant or financial guarantor** - The balance amount: Certificate of Bank Balance over \$18,000 ※ Deposit need to be frozen at least until start of the semester (March, 2022) ※ Recognition of the balance certificate issued within 30 days of the application date(However, if there is an expiration date of the balance certificate, it is recognized up to 6 months.)

	[5-2] In person or Financial guarantor's** <b>Proof of employment or Certificate of career</b> copy (notarized in English if it is not in English) ※ company name, tenure, and position
	[5-3] In person or Financial guarantor's** <b>Proof of income</b> copy(notarized in English if it is not in English)
	**Financial Witnesses: Only Parents of applicants(siblings, relatives can not be financial witnesses) ※ Special case of financial verification for Vietnamese students - Method of proof : Submit 'Confirmation of deposit for study abroad expenses' at At Vietnamese branch of Korean banks (Ex: Wooribank, Shinhan Bank, Hana Bank)
